Welcome to the Photography Competition at the Tumbarumba Spring Flower Festival, where we invite all photography enthusiasts to capture the vibrant beauty of spring. Let your camera become your paintbrush, and your subjects your canvas. Join us in capturing the essence of spring at this year's Photography Competition. Share your passion for photography, and let your images bloom!

#### **Section 1: Embrace the Theme**

## Theme: "Buttons and Butterflies"

In Section 1, we invite you to align your photography with the festival's theme: "Buttons and Butterflies." Let your lens explore the intricate details of nature, the graceful dance of butterflies, or the charming world of buttons. Entries should be up to A4 size, allowing you to express your creative vision with clarity and precision. This is your chance to interpret the theme in a way that's uniquely yours.

#### **Section 2: Postcard Perfect Moments**

In Section 2, we've made it even easier to participate with postcard-size prints (6 inches x 4 inches). Choose from three captivating categories:

- **A. Single Flower**: Showcase the beauty and elegance of a single flower. Capture its details, colors, and unique character. Every blossom tells a story.
- **B. Multi-Flowers**: Create a visual bouquet by photographing a delightful cluster of flowers. Show us how different blooms come together to create harmony.
- **C. Garden Landscape:** Step back and capture the grandeur of a garden landscape. Highlight the interplay of nature, colours, and design that makes gardens come alive.

- **Recognition:** Prizes and recognition await the most outstanding entries, with special attention to emerging talent.

## **Entry fee**

There is no entry fee for any of the photography competitions.

#### **Guidelines:**

- Everyone is welcome to enter the Photography Competition. The most important rule is to enjoy yourselves.
- Each entrant can submit up to three photos per category.
- Photographs will be the work of the person entering the competition.
- Submissions should be in physical print format, with your name, category, and contact details on the back.
- Entries in Section 2 should be of gardens in the Tumbarumba region and presented as 6 inch x 4 inch prints on black card photo
- Digital manipulation should be kept to a minimum to preserve the authenticity of your vision.
- All photographs should be taken within the last 12 months leading up to the competition.
- Winners will be announced, and presentations will be made at the Basketball Stadium at the Tumbarumba Showgrounds on Sunday 29 October 2023 at 2pm.
- Images of works may be used for promotion and publicity purposes.
- Entries and exhibits in the festival may be offered for sale. The festival charges a 10% commission.
- All unsold artwork must be picked up from the Basketball Stadium between 3:45 and 4:30pm on Sunday 29 October.
