Get inspired to create a sculpture for the 2024 Tumbarumba Spring Flower Festival. We invite artists of all ages and skill levels to transform ordinary materials into extraordinary works of art.

The theme – "Silver Jubilee"

Celebrating its 25th year, the theme for this year's festival is "Silver Jubilee". You might be inspired by things shiny, sparkling, silver and even magical. There is also the purple iris that is used in silver jubilee celebrations. Or why not take inspiration from what's happened in the last 25 years, perhaps even creating a time capsule. The possibilities are endless.

Embrace the "Silver Jubilee" theme if it inspires you, or follow your creative instincts with other ideas. This competition celebrates both themed and non-themed sculptures, inviting a diverse range of artistic expression.

Judging and Prizes

- Best of Theme: Awarded first.
- "General" category: Judged next with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes. Winners of "Best of Theme" are not eligible for General category prizes.

Guidelines

Welcome: Everyone is invited to enter and enjoy the competition.

Entry fee: A fee of \$5 per sculpture for the open section; free for high school and primary school sections.

Materials: Sculptures can be made from any material(s).

Theme: Sculptures do not need to follow the theme "Silver Jubilee". Indicate on the entry form if you want to be considered for "Best of theme".

Originality: Entries must be original works created by the entrant(s) within the past 2 years and not previously entered in the Tumbarumba Spring Flower Festival. Previous works may be exhibited at the organisers' discretion.

Liability: The Festival takes care but assumes no responsibility for any damage to sculptures.

Sales: Entries can be offered for sale with a 10% commission to the Festival.

Publicity: Photos of sculptures may be used for promotional purposes.

Logistics: Entrants are responsible for delivering and collecting their sculptures.

Display: Sculptures will be displayed indoors where possible. For outdoor displays, inform organisers in advance and ensure sculptures are securely installed.

Awards: Winners will be announced, and presentations will be made on Sunday, 27 October 2024, at 2pm in the Stadium at Tumbarumba Showgrounds.

By entering, participants agree to these guidelines and understand the judging and prize allocation process.

How to enter

- Bring your sculpture to the Tumbarumba Showground Stadium on Friday 25 October between 1pm and 5pm for installation. If your sculpture involves a special installation, discuss your requirements with the curator of the exhibit. You will be responsible for the installation.
