Welcome to the 2025 Tumbarumba Spring Flower Festival Photography Competition. Open to everyone. This year the theme is *In The Wild*.

Section 1: Embrace the Theme – "In The Wild" You might be inspired by the Australian bush or your interpretation of wilderness; wild animals or wild hair! The possibilities are endless. (Prints up to A4)

Section 2: In a Garden - Anything you like, but it must be in a garden. (Prints 6x4)

Section 3: Single Bloom - A photograph of a single flower. Make it stand out. (Prints 6x4)

Section 4: Landscape - A photo of a landscape scene from anywhere you like. (Prints 6x4)

Entry fee - There is no entry fee for the photography competition.

Guidelines:

- Each entrant can submit up to two photos per section.
- Photographs will be the work of the person entering the competition.
- Submissions should be in physical print format. (Prints 6x4 and up to A4 in Theme.)
- Images of works may be used for promotion and publicity purposes.
- Entries in the festival may be offered for sale. The Festival charges a 15% commission.
- All unsold artwork must be picked up from the Stadium between 3:45 and 4:30pm on Sunday 26 October.
- NOTE: This year photos will be attached directly to the display board using blue tack no mounting card required

PHOTOGRAPHY HINTS:

- Aim to make your image stand out from the background
- Avoid distractions behind the image.
- Choose good light. Not harsh midday but softer morning or late afternoon.

PRINTING HINTS:

- Crop your image to the print size. In this case either A4 (theme) or 6x4 to avoid chopping part of your image at the printer.
- If printed on a home printer, make sure the printer settings match the photo paper.
- Use Photographic paper.
