### The theme – 'In the Wild'

The theme for this year's festival is 'In the Wild'.

You might be inspired by the Australian bush or your interpretation of wilderness; wild animals or wild hair! The possibilities are endless.

Embrace the theme if it inspires you, or follow your creative instincts with ideas of your own. This competition celebrates both themed and non-themed sculptures, inviting a diverse range of artistic expression.

### **Guidelines**

**Welcome:** Everyone is invited to enter and enjoy the competition.

**Entry fee:** A fee of \$5 per sculpture for the open category. Entry is free for high school and primary school categories.

**Materials:** Sculptures can be made from any material(s).

**Theme:** 'In the Wild'.

Please indicate on the entry form if your work is to be considered for 'Best of theme'.

NB Sculptures do not need to follow the theme.

**Originality:** Entries must be original works created by the entrant(s) within the past 2 years and not previously entered in the Tumbarumba Spring Flower Festival. Previous works may be exhibited at the organisers' discretion.

**Liability:** The Festival takes care but assumes no responsibility for any damage to sculptures.

Sales: Entries can be offered for sale with a 15% commission to the Festival.

**Publicity:** Photos of sculptures may be used for festival promotional purposes.

**Logistics:** Entrants are responsible for delivering and collecting their sculptures.

**Display:** Sculptures will be displayed indoors where possible. For outdoor displays, inform organisers in advance and ensure sculptures are securely installed.

**Awards:** Winners will be announced, and presentations will be made on Sunday, 26 October 2025, at 2pm in the Stadium at Tumbarumba Showgrounds.

By entering, participants agree to these guidelines and understand the judging and prize allocation process.
