Welcome to the 2026 Tumbarumba Spring Flower Festival Quilt Competition. This exciting competition is run for the first time.

Section 1: Embrace the Theme – “Opposites” - There is plenty of scope for your imagination, as we are surrounded by opposites all the time. Let your imagination run wild, and try something a little different.

Section 2: Open – Anything goes - Traditional or Art quilt – the choice is yours

Section 3: Under 16 years – “My Garden” - Traditional or Art quilt depicting garden scene/flower

Section 4: Under 12 years - Patchwork table runner – any style you like

Section 5: Under 8 years - Collage using small bits of materials and fibres to make a picture – get creative: (**5a**: 6 to 8 years; **5b**: Pre-School 5 years and under)

- **Entry fee:** A fee of \$5 per quilt in section 1 and 2; free entry for sections 3, 4 and 5.
- **Size and materials:**

Quilts in section 1,2 and 3 must be no longer than 22 inches by 22 inches (56 cm).

Patchwork runner must be no longer than 12 inches (30.5 cm) wide and 24 inches (61 cm) long.

Collage: Using material or fibre, make a picture on a A3 size piece of paper.
- **Liability:** The Festival takes care but assumes no responsibility for any damage to the artwork.
- **Publicity:** Photographs of artworks may be used for promotional purposes.
- **Logistics:** Entrants are responsible for delivering and collecting their artworks.
